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true rate being about 4 per minute annual parallax 95 we have already seen that no displacement of the observer due to a change of position on the earth's surface could apparently affect the direction of a fixed star however as the earth in its annual motion describes an orbit of about 92 million miles radius round the sun the different positions in space from which an observer views the fixed stars from time to time throughout the year must be separated

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
